

# POOL RULES



1. Be kind to our neighbors, guards, and staff.
2. We ask all patrons to have a current Season Pass, Coupon or paid Entrance Fee for entrance into the facility.
3. Please have an adult accompany children under the age of 13.
4. You know when you are feeling ill. If you are under the weather, reschedule your trip for the safety of yourself and everyone around you.
5. This is a family-friendly facility: Alcohol and smoking/vaping of any kind is not permitted. The Round Lake Area Park District reserves the right to deny admission to anyone appearing to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
6. We require that all swim patrons wear proper swim attire. Street clothes, shoes and cotton underwear are not proper swim attire.
  - \* For children who are not toilet trained, proper swim attire is a swim diaper.
7. We provide life jackets for use in the facility free of charge. Please do not bring your children in flotation bathing suits.
8. To help our staff keep all our swimmers safe, we ask that you leave your inflatable devices and toys at home. These toys can make it difficult to see the bottom of the pool.
9. We have rules and guidelines in place to keep you, your loved ones, our neighbors, and our staff safe. We ask that while in our facility you follow instructions from the guards and are kind to others around you.
  - \* We do not want to have to remove anyone from the facility, but if you are not listening and putting others in harm's way, we reserve the right to remove you from the facility without a refund.
10. The admissions desk has snacks and cold drinks available for purchase to be enjoyed on the concession deck. We have picnic tables available outside of the facility for you to sit at if you choose to bring your own food.
11. If thunder is heard or lightning is seen, the facility will close and will remain closed for a 30-minute period after the last lightning or thunder is detected.
12. Be mindful of what you bring with you to the facility. Many times we leave our bags unattended while we are enjoying the water. The Round Lake Area Park District cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items.
13. Our list of NO's:
  - \*No running
  - \*No rough play
  - \*No smoking/vaping
  - \*No outside food
  - \*No glass containers
  - \*No abusive or foul language
14. The Round Lake Area Park District is here to serve our community, friends and neighbors. These are just a few guidelines and rules in place to help everyone feel welcome. Management staff do have the authority to implement and enforce stricter or supplement those that are not listed here at this time. We are all in this together!
