Recreation aides assist the Camp Counselors with day-to-day activities at camp. Inclusion aids may work one-on-one or with up to four campers depending on enrollment and unique camper needs.

Positions are available in both our Teen Camp and Summer Trails School Aged Camp.

Training begins in May. Camp begins June 10, 2019. Approximately 35 hours per week depending on camp enrollment. This is a seasonal position.

Qualifications: Must be at least 16 years old. Experience working with children with special needs is a plus but not required.
